TERMINAL 5, Changing the way you think about Airports

In May we flew into Nice, rented a car and spent a week exploring the lyrical Côte d'Azur. Historically, artists have loved this area for its limpid light and vibrant colours. Although wealth and conspicuous glamour are the hallmark of this corner of Provence, in sublime weather, we explored the less trampled hinterland. From vantage points in elevated villages, it was possible to glimpse the dramatic Mediterranean shoreline and reap the rewards of exploring the quieter roads.

Our route, and the Concierge Tom Tom*, took us not just through the physical landscape of this corner of Provence but also provided a satisfying exposure to its gourmet and traditional cuisine, market towns, architectural pleasures, history and landscapes that have inspired the best loved of French artists. The first stop was at the fortified and fabled village of Saint Paul de Vence where we indulged in a Provencal feast at the unassuming, La Colombe D'Or. It satisfied the palate and the eye as the walls are hung with paintings by Picasso, Klee and Miró.

From there we drove via the centuries old market town of Vence where Matisse left his magic touch on a modest, blue-tiled, sand-coloured chapel. The exterior belies the explosion of colour inside. Next stop was Grasse to visit the Musée de la Parfumerie that deals with 3000 years of perfume history and the evening's destination was Mosutiers-Sainte-Marie, another elevated village steeped in the scent of lavender, and dotted with olive trees. We celebrated a wondrous view of the setting sun with an excessively good Ducasse-inspired meal.

It was less than a 2 hour drive back to Mougins, a medieval village set amongst pine, olive and cypress trees, with a panoramic view of the Bay of Cannes and filled with carefully restored houses. In its narrow and ancient streets we were able to walk off the excess of the some previous meals.

Finally, we returned to our starting point to take in museums dedicated to Chagall and Matisse. Nowhere in the week took us further than 2 hours from Nice, but a destination technically no more than 30 minutes from our starting point, easily took a whole day in the living. To enjoy this itinerary does not require a different inn each night. A villa is an equally ideal base for a similar tour.



CROATIA (1)

Dubrovnik has everything: a magnificent natural setting, an old town unspoilt by development and a lively cultural life. Walk along the old Harbour Front, dip your hands in the Fountain of Onofrio and then stroll down the Stradun. The coastline of Dubrovnik is dotted with islands. Visit the Istian Peninsula and the Dalmation coast by yacht. Must see: a private guided tour of the Diocletian Palace in Split, truffle hunting, the open-air museum that is Istra or unwind in luxury in Opatija.

Areas of old Moscow still exist, most famously Red Square with its landmark St Basil's Cathedral. There is also the very new oil-rich Moscow of designer shops and men in black. The Bolshoi Theatre is closed for refurbishment until 2010; however see the ballet and opera companies and the orchestra perform on the new Small Stage of the Bolshoi

and at the Kremlin Palace theatre. In 1779 Peter the Great dreamed about a city that would be as unlike Moscow as possible, a modern city that would be designed to a plan. He realised his dream with the building of St Petersburg. Giving it a new style; Baroque, Rococo, Classical and Russian Revival. A must see in Moscow is a visit to the Kremlin and the Armoury, plus a weekend shopping at the Ismailovsky market. In St Petersburg it has to be the Hermitage including the Gold Rooms, and the baroque Catherine Palace.

A POLISH EXPERIENCE - KRAKOW (4)

Poland's former capital and oldest university town lies in a valley beside the Vistula River, and is a treasure house of national culture. Its elegant Old Town centre has been placed on the UNESCO list of World Historic Sites. Krakow, in contrast to Warsaw, is a human-scale, medieval town at the hub of which is a market square that bustles with music, cafes, restaurants, market stalls and students. St Mary's Cathedral, located in one corner of the square, has ceiling decorations that stun even the most jaded of cathedral visitors.

The irony of gorgeous Krakow is its proximity to Auschwitz-Birkenau. The 2 camps are just 50 km's away, in the

countryside. A visit is essential but a return to Krakow in the evening is a necessary balm to the harsh reality of the camps. Krakow was the headquarters for the Gestapo and it was therefore not destroyed in WWII. For accommodation, it is best to select hotels that are slightly removed from, but still within easy walking distance of the main square – it tends to be a source of youthful exuberance into the small hours of the morning.


