A WALK IN ALPINE MEADOWS

For anyone who enjoys a blend of raw outdoor beauty, fresh air, delicious food and indulgent inns, John Chekian reckons that this Backroads Alpine walk is unique.

The walk begins in one of the most beautiful lakeside towns in France - Annecy and finishes in the alpine village of Chamonix. Annecy is a postcard city of canals and Michelin starred restaurants. East of Annecy, near the Swiss border, is the winter resort town of Chamonix. It is a base for hikers, climbers and those wanting take the Aiguille du Midi cable car up to a 3,842 m terrace to view Mont Blanc and surrounding peaks.



The maximum group size is 20 with at least two vehicles for support. Directions are provided for those who like to venture out on more difficult trails; walk as fast or slow as you like and share the trail with whom you choose; don crampons and try a glacier walk with experts if you want to be more adventurous.

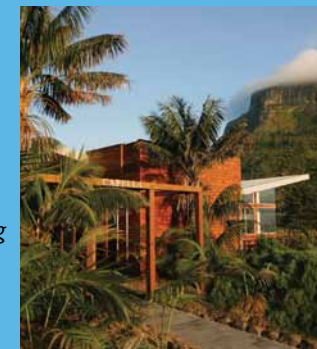
HOWE IT'S DONE AT CAPELLA

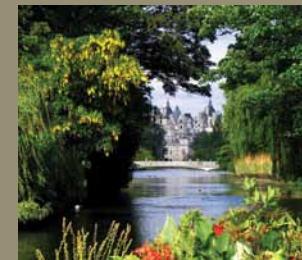

LINDBLAD FOR SAILORS

Since 1966 Lindblad Expeditions have pioneered what is now often referred to as eco-tourism, offering extraordinary cruises to any place on the globe that shines in the naturalist firmament. Their vessels, with ice-strengthened hulls, sail mostly to polar latitudes but occasionally venture to remote Pacific locations, including the Galapagos Islands.

Think expedition ship rather than pleasure boat and you'll find the ship is a strong and agile work-horse. It's got a pleasing but unusual profile and numerous cranes for launching kayaks and Zodiacs that punctuate its superstructure.

Forget cabins with balconies, casinos and room service. Instead, you'll use the ship as a moving base camp and itineraries are never immutable. Weather, wildlife and sea conditions might often dictate daily

events. You'll spend your trip happily waking up at 2 a.m. when you hear an announcement about a curious animal approaching the ship to take a closer look. The Galapagos is an other-worldly place where you can see marine iguanas, entertaining penguins, flightless cormorants, lumbering sea lions and exotic blue-footed boobies.

Each cruise is staffed with very approachable, expert naturalists and is equipped with sophisticated and unique "toys" that can record astonishing images below the surface of the ocean. For passengers this means the thrilling possibility to get up more close and personal with fabulous marine creatures than you ever expected. Hydrophones record underwater "chatter" and a high definition camera allows the undersea specialist to film the underwater life whenever he dives.

National Geographic Society photographers often accompany a sailing, allowing passengers to get personalised instruction from some of the best photographers in the world.

For those who worry that it might be just a simple, spartan ship with spare décor and minimalist facilities, think again. Julie Richards describes the NG Endeavour as a well-maintained and attractive ship full of charm and character. Nothing about these expeditions means deprivation and she rates them as a healthy dose of excitement, discovery and restorative fun. Ask her about the dates on which you can travel with the expert National Geographic photographers.
